Foyer Lacombe is situated, along with the St. Albert Catholic Parish Church and the Star of the North Retreat Centre, on Mission Hill in St. Albert. The building overlooks a scenic view of grass and trees. It is connected by a hallway to the Foyer apartments, which are managed and operated by OMI.

HISTORY

- Foyer Lacombe was purpose-built in 2002 and served as a private supportive living site for the Missionary Oblates and Diocesan priests until December 2014
- The building has remained vacant since January 2015
- The dining room and chapel continue to be used by those living in the Foyer apartments
