Overview

- 102 beds to care for supportive living level 4 (SL4) & SL4D (dementia care)
- 4.92 acre lot size
- 8,700 square metres (93,830 square feet)
- Three stories plus basement, wood frame construction
- \$26 million budget, with \$10 million provided by Government of Alberta
- Design by FWBA Architects and construction by Westcor Construction Ltd
- Construction begins Fall 2020
- Residents move in Spring 2022

Care philosophy

- Seniors will receive high-quality care in a warm and nurturing environment, in their home community near families and friends
- Purpose-built to enable seniors to remain independent and active in the community
- Flexibility to provide dementia care so residents can remain at St. Anne's if their needs change

What's in a name?

- St. Anne was the grandmother of Jesus and is the patron saint of grandparents
- St. Anne embodies the traditional importance of the grandmother among many faiths, traditions and cultures, including Indigenous Peoples in Canada
- Anne means favour and grace and signals a place of blessing, welcome and acceptance
- Haven denotes a place of shelter, safety and protection

Design highlights

- Follows government's design standards to ensure the facility will have maximum flexibility to adapt to higher level of care, ensuring seniors have the supports they need as their needs change
- Engaged with the community to ensure it would meet the needs of its future residents, but also of the community more broadly
- Honours our Catholic heritage and recognize the contributions of our founding congregation, Sisters of St. Martha.
- Modern prairie design with large windows throughout to ensure residents enjoy plenty of natural light
- Pergolas, a walk-out basement, outdoor patio and terraced garden promote safe outdoor access
- Resident units arranged in cozy, home-like groupings (houses), each with their own dining, living and therapy areas
- Each floor will have two houses of 17 suites each to promote resident interaction
- Resident suites have an accessible washroom, kitchenette and storage
- Common use areas include a family dining room, salon, family conference room, spa-like tub rooms and resident laundry area
- A chapel with a stained glass window will be a peaceful space for residents, family and staff of all faiths
