Dear Villa Marie families, residents, and staff,

We are pleased to let you know that the COVID outbreak at Villa Marie has been lifted.

The residents and staff who tested positive are doing well and have made a full recovery. Staff continue to monitor residents and themselves regularly for any sign of symptoms.

Effective immediately, residents are no longer required to wear a mask in common areas and recreational activities and other services will begin. We are pleased to welcome visitors to the site. Please remember that visitors must be fully immunized or show proof of a negative COVID test taken at your own expense and within 72 hours of your visit. If you are unvaccinated or partially vaccinated and prefer to not take the test, we can arrange for you to visit with your loved one in our front room.

Thank you to families for your support and understanding through the outbreak. Thank you to residents for their good humour and patience. And thank you to our team for caring for residents with compassion and for their diligence in following all public health protocols.
